School Trips

Important Information regarding School trips- it is essential that if your child has brought home a permission slip for a school trip that this is signed and returned to school-this includes all afterschool sports competitions which are off site (please keep the main body of your letter so that you know where and when your child should be picked up. **Due to safeguarding requirements we will no longer be ringing on the day if your child's slip is not returned as verbal permission is not acceptable. Any child without written permission will not take part in the trip.**

KS2 SATs

It is essential that all Year 6 children are in school every day for the week of 14th May so that they can sit the end of primary school national tests- SATs. Please be aware that if your child is off for any reason that week it is unlikely they will be able to sit the test.

Data Protection

From 25th May 2018, the Data Protection Act will be replaced by the General Data Protection Register- meaning the way we manage all data and information in school will change. I have attached an information leaflet for you to read which explains some of the changes. On Monday 30th May school staff and governors will be undertaking GDPR training to ensure that our policies and procedures are in line with the changes (there are no clubs or afterschool care on this day). We have also created a GDPR page on our website which we will populate with new information as it becomes available. Due to the significant changes you will, in the next few weeks, be receiving documents asking for consent for your child to access some learning sites that access data on your child- this can be anything from their name to their assessment results. In order for us to be compliant with the new changes it is essential that these documents are signed and returned to school asap. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.

ECO Club
